All woodworkers are invited to apply for the 9th annual Made of Wood Show (MOWS), taking place in the village of Erin, Ontario from April 17 to May 9, 2010. This exhibition will highlight a selection of Canada's finest woodworkers and will run in conjunction with wood demonstrations, seminars and workshops in the community of Erin. The Made of Wood Show has been held annually since 2001.

This is the second year that the Made of Wood Show exhibition will be juried. This has been done in order to attract a wider selection of professional works including a range of woodworking techniques and practices. A gallery owner, a woodturner and a glassblower will sit on the jury and choose the final works according to excellence, design, use of material, creativity and innovation. Organized by the OCC and the Made of Wood Show, and displayed at the Burdette Gallery, the Paul Morin Gallery and in selected store fronts in the village of Erin, the exhibition will contribute a diverse and exciting display of professional work to the event's celebration of "all things wood".

## Conditions of Entry:

1. A completed application form with accompanying digital images must be received by email at [submissions@madeofwoodshow.com](mailto:submissions@madeofwoodshow.com) by Monday, March 15, 2010, 5:00pm.
2. To enter, your work must be at least 80% made of wood and you must be a permanent resident of Canada.
3. All entries must be original, completed within the last 5 years, and not shown previously in this juried exhibition.
4. You may submit up to 2 works. A set of multiples such as a sculptural group, will be considered as one work.
5. A work may not be withdrawn from the exhibition once it has been accepted as a finalist.
6. Your submission must include a current CV, artist statement and biography in either a Word document, text or pdf format.
7. You may only submit digital images and a total of three images per work.
8. Late or incomplete entries will not be accepted.



9. The artist, by submission of entry, grants the Ontario Crafts Council (OCC), Dufferin County Museum and Archives (DCMA) and the Made of Wood Show (MOWS) the right to photograph accepted work for future publicity and promotion. While copyright remains with the artist, submission of entry grants the OCC, DCMA, and MOWS permission to use images of accepted works for all promotional purposes.

## Show Details:

1. Jurors will assess work according to excellence, design, use of material, creativity and innovation.
2. Please indicate if the work is for sale. The Made of Wood Show will receive a 40% commission on all sales. The remainder (60%) will be paid to the artists by June 15, 2010.
3. Notification of acceptance will be by email only. Accepted applicants will receive an email in late March detailing further requirements such as delivery times, the delivery location and shipping instructions..
4. Unsold works may be picked up or arrangements can be made for delivery after the show. Delivery and return of work will be at the artist's expense.
5. Accepted pieces will be covered for their insured value while part of the juried exhibition. Insurance while the pieces are in transit is the responsibility of the applicant.
6. Application to the Made of Wood Show 2009 Juried Exhibition indicates agreement with the terms and conditions listed herein.

## Image Requirements:

1. The Made of Wood Show will only be accepting digital photos for this call for entry. Images must be in JPEG format, 300 dpi and approximately 4x6 inches (1200 x 1800 pixels) in size. Images larger than 2.25 MB will not be accepted.
2. Applicants may enter 2 separate pieces for jurying with 3 photos per piece. One image should illustrate relative scale by being positioned beside a known object and the other 2 images should be taken from different angles, at greater than 60 degrees either horizontally or vertically, illustrating two different views of the work. In each of these two images the whole work must be visible. Submitting less than 3 images per piece minimizes your chances of acceptance.



3. Format your image file names without spaces or capitalization. Please title each image in the following manner: First Initial, Last Name, Piece# & Image a,b,or c. Examples: JLorriman1a, JLorriman1b, JLorriman1c, JLorriman2a, etc.

4. The quality of your images is critical to your success in the jury process. Submit high-quality images on a plain background. Evenly distribute lighting from at least three light sources so that no shadows are cast. Hire a professional photographer to photograph your work whenever possible.

If you are overwhelmed by these requirements, take the above requirements to your photography professional and get their help. As a last resort, you can email [images@madeofwoodshow.com](mailto:images@madeofwoodshow.com), and we will format your images for you at a charge of \$5.00 per image.
